RULES AND REGULATIONS

1 Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.

2 The Society reserves the right to refuse entries.

3 No substitutions while reserves stand.

4 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the event can be made.

All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

5 If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial /Test shall be decided by ballot.

6 Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.

7 No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.

8 Judges at a Trial /Test are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.

9 Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the Chief Steward and the host.

10 Welfare of Dogs-

A competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise.

A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

11. DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.

If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
